Students who are seeking accommodations, based on disability, on College Board tests (i.e., SAT® AP® PSAT/NMSQT®) must follow several important steps. Here are several other important things to know:

... accommodations on their tests. Often these accommodations are the same as those your child receives at school, but not always. It is not automatic that school accommodations will be the same as those approved for College Board tests.
